MEMORY VERSE

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) If you could play a round of golf or any sport with any athlete, past or present, who would it be and why?

Read John 6:8-11. In what area(s) do you feel like the world needs more from you than you have to offer? How does this story change your perspective?

What holds you back from offering what you have, big or small, to be used by God?

When the young boy offered his few loaves and fish, Jesus chose to multiply an offering from someone's generosity instead of creating something himself. How can we apply this type of generosity in our daily lives for Jesus to multiply?

Jesus says "it is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35). Have you found this to be true? Give an example.

Read John 6:14. Meeting physical needs has spiritual impact! Tell about a time you saw evidence of this in your own life or in someone in your community.

How have you been challenged to live differently this next week because of this sermon?
