WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Matthew 4:18-20

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) Being a Christ follower means you live in a rhythm of inviting others to follow Him.

INVITE YOUR FAMILY TO FOLLOW

INVITE THE NEXT GENERATION TO FOLLOW

INVITE THE PEOPLE AROUND YOU TO FOLLOW

MEMORY VERSE

"Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him. -Matthew 4:19

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) Game Time: Who in our group thinks they can name the most disciples? Whoever names the most gets a gold star.

Let's read Matthew 4:18-20. What does it mean for someone to be a "fisher of people"?

Tell us about a time you brought someone to Jesus.

Andrew brought all kinds of people to Jesus—his family, the next generation, and the people around him. Which of those three groups do you feel the most conviction to share Jesus with?
