WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Luke 15:1-7

EVERY **ONE** NEEDS JESUS

EVERY **ONE** SHOULD FEEL PURSUED BY JESUS

EVERY **ONE** IS WORTH CELEBRATING

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) Christians are consumed by the <u>ONE</u> because Jesus is consumed by the <u>ONE</u>.

MEMORY VERSE

I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent. -Luke 15:7 NIV

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) Adam told the story of a car his family had growing up with a finicky window that they jammed closed with a doorstop. What's the funniest or strangest way you have "fixed" an issue like that?

Adam listed some signs of a church drifting away from its purpose–i.e., congregants fighting about personal preferences, taking on an "us vs. them" mentality toward other churches, prioritizing the saved over the lost, etc. What warning signs do you look for in your own life that indicate you are drifting from your purpose as a Jesus follower?

Read the parables found in Luke 15:4-10. Have you ever known someone who had this kind of passion for lost people? What did they do to bring people to Jesus?

Share about a time you shared the gospel with someone (or planted the seed) and saw positive results, even if they weren't immediate.

What stops you from doing whatever it takes to share Jesus with others? What is one step you can take this week to share the gospel?

So, who's your one? Pray for each other's "one" together as a group.
