WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Luke 8:40-48

EVERYONE NEEDS THE POWER OF JESUS IN THEIR LIFE

PROXIMITY TO JESUS DOESN'T RELEASE THE POWER OF JESUS

FAITH IS PERSONAL, BUT NEVER PRIVATE

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) The power of Jesus is available to those who reach out for it.

MEMORY VERSE

Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace." -Luke 8:48 NIV

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) How did the sermon's call for baptism impact you? What is your personal baptism story?

Adam mentioned that there is a difference between church-going and Christ-following. What is the difference and which one are you doing?

Read Romans 6:23. Even as Christ-followers, it can be tempting to defend our sins. What defenses do you find yourself using to reduce the weight of your sin? How does that impact your relationship with Jesus as your Savior?

Read Luke 8:40-48. Jesus asked the woman to give her witness publicly, allowing her to confess Christ, glorify God, and encourage those around her. Is there anything holding you back from going public with your faith? What would you say to somebody who is struggling with this?

This week we finished talking about the "one," and next week we will start a series about the season of Lent and preparing for Easter. How will you use the perspective you gained over the last several weeks to help you prepare for Easter?

Though this was the last week of the series, it should not be the last week of pursuing your ONE(s). If you have an update about yours, share it, then pray for each other's ONE as a group.
