Sermon: Amazing Grace

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Ephesians 2:1-9; John 8:1-11

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) You were... But God... By grace.

MEMORY VERSE

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. -Ephesians 2:8-9

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) What is your best "bless their heart" story?

You were, but God, by grace is the basic formula for telling your testimony. Consider taking time to allow a couple people to share their story. OR Describe a "but God" moment in your life.

How would you describe "grace"? Why is it so important to you?

Have you ever felt unworthy of God's grace? How does Paul's story (murderer) and the woman caught in adultery (John 8) challenge those feelings of unworthiness?

Look up the lyrics to the song Amazing Grace. Which parts of the song do you especially identify with? Why?

Take a silent moment to think about all the ways grace has saved you. As you think of something, feel free to share it out loud in a couple of words.

Which part of your life do you need to allow God's grace to come in and transform?

Who in your life needs a little extra grace? How will you practically do that this week?
