## WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

John 16:16-33

THERE IS JOY IN TRANSFORMATION

THERE IS JOY IN PRAYER

THERE IS JOY IN VICTORY

**(SERMON IN A SENTENCE)** The outcome of Easter is joy.

### MEMORY VERSE

Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete. -John 16:24 NIV

## WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) Quick! Name three things that have brought you joy this week.

Read John 16:20-22. We often talk about how Jesus' *sacrifice* transforms us from sinners to saved, which is a great thing to celebrate! More specifically, how has his *joy* transformed you?

Adam made the point that there is joy found in prayer. Has that been your experience with prayer so far? How does it change your perspective when you pray knowing that it can lead to joy?

Read John 16:23-28. Jesus said, "Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete." Does this verse mean all your prayers will be answered? Why or why not?

What is something in your life that you have not yet claimed victory over? How can you live differently this week to reflect that you have victory in Jesus?
