(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) God uses great teams to accomplish impossible things.

MEMORY VERSE

1 Timothy 4:7-8 NIV

The sermon in a sentence was "God uses great teams to accomplish impossible things." What is an example you've seen of a great team accomplishing the impossible?

Read 1 Timothy 4:7-8. What does "train yourself to be godly" mean to you? What would change if you took this training as seriously as the rowers in *Boys in the Boat*?

Read Acts 4:32. Is this the approach you have with other believers? How can you adjust so that you are more unified with the body of Christ?

Read Acts 4:18-20. The disciples persevered in teaching though they faced major difficulties and opposition. Would you persevere in the same way? Why or why not?

Adam listed three qualities of a great team as represented in *Boys in the Boat*: discipline, unity, and perseverance. Who do you know who embodies one or all of these qualities? How will you strive to improve in these areas this week?
