Sermon: To Know and be Known

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WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Psalms 139

1. **We are Known by God** (Psalm 139:1-6)
2. **We are Loved & Valued by God** (Psalm 139:13-18)
3. **We are Led by God** (Psalm 139:23-24)

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) Our identity is found in being known, being loved and being led by God.

MEMORY VERSE

Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my concerns. See if there is any offensive way in me; lead me in the everlasting way. – Psalm 139:23-24 CSB

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) Besides your spouse and God, who knows you the best?

Read Psalm 139

How does it feel to know that God is aware of every aspect of your life?

In what ways can we embrace the security that comes from being known by God?

How does understanding that God knows us intimately impact our daily lives and our identity?

Have you ever felt alone? How does knowing God is always with you change that feeling?

Share a time when you experienced God's presence in a difficult situation.

How can we remind ourselves of God's constant presence in our daily lives?

What does it mean to you to be "fearfully and wonderfully made"?

How can we discover and embrace the purpose God has for our lives?

How does knowing that God has a plan for us change our perspective on our identity and future?
