## WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

(Icebreaker) At the beginning of the sermon, Adam showed a video of a dog with incredible willpower. What food would not be safe if you were left alone with it?

This week’s Sermon in a Sentence was: “One day, our commitment to God will be tested against our commitment to everything else.” Have you experienced one of those days/seasons? How did you handle it?

Read Esther 3:1-6. Have you ever seen someone else take a stand for their faith or values in a difficult situation? How was it received, and what impact did it have on them or others?

Circles are better than rows. Surrounding yourself with the right people is a vital part of withstanding tests in life. How has being in this community group helped you to stay strong in your commitment to God?

Three action steps were at the end of the sermon: Draw a line, surround yourself with the right people, and get ready for attack. How can you practically take those steps this week?
