WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Acts 17:16-34, Matthew 28:18-20

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) Disciple-making happens through people, not programs!

DISCIPLE-MAKING HAPPENS ANYTIME A BURDEN IS MOBILIZED IN THE DIRECTION OF OTHERS

DISCIPLE-MAKING HAPPENS ANYTIME WE POINT PEOPLE IN THE DIRECTION OF JESUS

DISCIPLE-MAKING HAPPENS ANYTIME SOMEONE TAKES A STEP CLOSER TO JESUS

MEMORY VERSE

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.-Matthew 28:19-20 NIV

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

ICEBREAKER: What is one task you're responsible for (as part of your job or daily responsibilities) that might surprise people?

Read Acts 17:22-23. What "burdens" or passions has God placed in your heart that could be mobilized to help disciple others? How might you act on those?

Read Matthew 28:18-20. Who are the people in your life that you could be more intentional about discipling or helping grow in their faith? What's one practical step you could take this week?

What challenges or fears come up for you when thinking about the responsibility of discipling others? How did this sermon encourage you?
