WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Genesis 2:15

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) God created us to carry responsibility!

GIVE YOUR BEST TO WHAT YOU DO

THANK GOD FOR WHAT YOU DO

PROVIDE FOR OTHERS THROUGH WHAT YOU DO

MEMORY VERSE

The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it. -Genesis 2:15 NIV

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

ICEBREAKER: What was your first job? What did it teach you about responsibility?

Genesis 2:15 shows God placing Adam in the garden to "work it and take care of it." How does seeing work as God's idea change how we approach our responsibilities?

This week's sermon talked about three ways to approach work: Give your best at work, thank God for your work, and provide for others through your work. Which of those do you find most challenging?

Read Colossians 3:23-24. What's the difference between perfectionism and giving your best? How can we find that balance?

Read Ephesians 4:28. How does your work or daily responsibility serve others, either directly or indirectly?

Share a time when someone else's faithful work made a difference in your life. What impact did that have on you?

What's one practical step you can take this week to better reflect God's purpose for work in your life?
