- The passage speaks of holding "unswervingly" to hope. How do you differentiate between hope and faith? Do you think you can have one without the other?
- Read Hebrews 10:24–25. Share a time when someone "spurred you on" in your faith journey. How did their encouragement impact your hope in Christ?
- The last sermon point is that our hope is active in Jesus. What's the difference between passive and active hope? How can we practice active hope this week?
- Adam's sermon in a sentence was this: The gift of Jesus allows us to build our lives around the hope of Jesus. Imagine if you truly built your daily life around this hope.
 What would that look like for you?
