- 8. How can you encourage others to find joy in the hope of God's promises?
- **PRAY TOGETHER:** Pray specifically for yourself and others in the areas raised by questions 7 and 8. Pray for freedom from the control of the wrong master and for the strength to live in the new identity of Christ.
