WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Acts 8:9-13, 26-40

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) Followers of Jesus value the next one.

JESUS ESTABLISHES THE MODEL OF THE NEXT ONE FOR EVERYONE TO PARTICIPATE IN

THE NEXT ONE IS LOST

THE NEXT ONE IS CLOSE

ONCE YOU GET ONE, GO GET THE NEXT ONE

We Value **THE NEXT ONE**:

Those who had been scattered preached the word wherever they went.

Acts 8:4
