WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

- ICEBREAKER: When you hear the phrase “life is better together,” what comes to mind?
- Read Hebrews 3:13. What does this verse teach us about the importance of encouraging one another daily? Why do you think encouragement helps prevent the “deceitfulness of sin”?
- In Genesis 2:18 God says, “It is not good for man to be alone.” How does this foundational truth shape how we think about relationships and community?
- Tim Keller said, “Everyone says they want community and friendship, but when that means accountability or commitment people run the other way.” Why do you think people often resist accountability?
- How have you experienced the power of encouragement or accountability in your life? Share an example where someone walked alongside you through a challenging season or helped you grow spiritually?
- Read Galatians 6:2. What does it mean to “carry each other’s burdens”? How can we do this practically in our community group or church?
- Are there areas in your life where you’ve been trying to “go at it alone” instead of inviting community in? What would it look like to take a step toward greater vulnerability and connection?
