WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Isaiah 58:6-12

A conversation between our Community Engagement Pastor, Amy Raburn, and Lead Pastor, Adam Scott, about one of our five core values: Radical Generosity.

We Value **RADICAL GENEROSITY**:

God's blessings flow through us. We are excited to serve the world with all the He has given us: our time, our gifts, and our finances.

MEMORY VERSE

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. Philippians 2:3-4

WHAT DO I NEED TO ASK?

- ICEBREAKER: Share about a time when someone's generosity impacted you in a meaningful way. How did it make you feel?
- Read Isaiah 58:6-12. What does this passage teach us about the kind of generosity God desires from His people?
- What are some barriers that keep people from living generously? How can we work together to overcome them?
- It was said on Sunday that "God's blessings flow **through us**." How does this perspective challenge the way we think about our resources (time, talent, and finances)?
- How can we use our **gifts and talents** to bless those around us?
- How can we approach our **finances**, this week, in a way that aligns with God's call to generosity?
- Philippians 2:3-4 calls us to consider others above ourselves. What are some practical ways we can live this out individually, and as a group?
- What is one step that we, as a group, can take this week to be more intentional about living a life of radical generosity?
