- How does trusting God’s provision change the way we handle our finances, time, or talents?
- How can we encourage one another to take steps of trust in areas like serving, giving, and sharing our faith?
- What does our trust in God—or lack of trust—communicate to those around us who don’t follow Jesus?
- What does 100% participation in trusting God look like for us as individuals, as a group, and as a church?
