- How can we encourage one another to make sacrificial commitments without feeling pressured, but rather inspired by God's movement through us?
- Reflect on this phrase: "When we move as one, God moves through us." What excites or challenges you about that statement?
- What fears or hesitations do you feel as you consider your commitment? How can your group support you in prayer and encouragement?
- Looking two years ahead, what do you hope to celebrate because of your commitment today?
