- Timothy Keller said, "The solution to stinginess is a reorientation to the generosity of Christ." How has God's generosity toward you impacted the way you give?
- Jesus said He came "to seek and to save the lost" (Luke 19:10). How does this statement challenge the way we live out our faith?
- What does it mean that "One More Matters" in the kingdom of God? Who is someone in your life that God might be calling you to reach?
- "Be generous because Jesus is generous." What's one practical step you can take this week to embody this truth?
- Take a moment to pray as a group. Ask God to reveal how each person can step up in faith, generosity, and mission
