GENEROSITY SHAPES OUR HEARTS

(SERMON IN A SENTENCE) We're not just using generosity to build something for God, God is using it to build something in us.

GROUP DISCUSSION

- **ICEBREAKER:** Where did you unexpectedly see God's generosity this week?
- Share a time someone planted a 'tree' you're now sitting under
- In **1 Chronicles 29:10-13**, what attributes of God does David name before he ever mentions giving? What does that ordering teach us?
- In **1 Chronicles 29:17-18**, what does David ask God to do in the people's hearts? What does that assume about how generosity works?
- Where do you instinctively feel like an owner (my money, my time, my plan)? What would a steward say instead?
- David says, "Who am I... that we should be able to give?" (29:14). How does humility make generosity lighter, not heavier?

MEMORY VERSE: But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.

- 1 Chronicles 29:14 NIV

- How does worship protect us from giving to get something back (transaction), and invite us to give because God is worthy (adoration)
- Imagine talking about this season to a younger believer in 15 years and you are answering this question: "**How did God use that season to make you more like Jesus?**" What do you hope you'll say?
